

PMUA RESIDENTIAL COLLECTION SERVICES

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Quarterly (three months) Service Charge:

The quarterly charge (three months) is \$74.00. This includes two (2) 96 gallon containers; one for household waste and one for recyclable materials. The recycling container has a yellow lid. The \$74.00 charge is guaranteed to June 30, 2014 when our three year contract with Waste Management of New Jersey expires. If service is started during a quarter, the charge will be prorated based on the number of weeks remaining in the current quarter. Payment is by check, cash, on line bill payment through your bank or money order. A credit card option and electronic payment option will be available in April 2012. There will be a convenience charge for a credit card payment or electronic bill payment in addition to the \$74. Once you have signed up, it takes approximately one week for service to start. The service will also include a free, recycling rewards program beginning on or about April 1, 2012.

2. Collection Schedule:

Household Waste is collected once per week based on where you live. The Township is divided into four sections. Section 1 is collected on Mondays. Section 2 is collected on Tuesdays. Section 3 is collected on Thursdays and Section 4 is collected on Fridays. To determine which Section you are in for household waste, please use the Interactive Map or click on the Trash/Bulk Pickup Map or Street Listing links below for this information.

Bulky Waste* is collected once per month according to the following schedule:

If you are in Section 1 for household waste, your bulk pick up is Week 1.

If you are in Section 2 for household waste, your bulk pick up is Week 2.

If you are in Section 3 for household waste, your bulk pick up is Week 3.

If you are in Section 4 for household waste, your bulk pick up is Week 4.

Please note: you must go by the week numbers on the 2012 service calendar. To view the 2012 service calendar please click on the link below.

***Bulk waste** includes household items such as furniture, bed springs, mattresses, sofas and other bulky items of a household nature. Bulky waste also includes such items as dry wall and other building material resulting from home remodeling and home repair work performed by the resident or owner but excludes general contractors or commercial builders. Construction material must be placed in containers each not weighing more than fifty (50) pounds and not exceeding more than 100 pounds per collection. Wood must be cut in sections each less than four (4) feet in length. Christmas trees will be picked in January. Electronic equipment (such as computers, telephones, fax machines), household appliances (such as toasters and microwave ovens) and large appliances (such as washing machines, dryers) are not considered bulky waste.

Recycling:

All recycling collection occurs every other week on Wednesday based on where you live.

If you live **on or East of Route 539 (Pinehurst Road)** you are an **Odd Week** customer and your recycling collection will correspond to the weeks labeled **O** on the 2012 service calendar.

If you live **off of or West of Route 539 (Pinehurst Road)** you are an **Even Week** customer and your recycling collection will correspond to the weeks labeled **E** on the 2012 service calendar.

3. HOLIDAY SCHEDULE:

Waste Management observes the following holidays: New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. These days are highlighted on the 2012 service calendar.

If your scheduled pickup falls on or after a holiday, your pickup day will be delayed one day. For example, if the holiday falls on a Monday (like Memorial Day and Labor Day), Monday's household waste will be collected on Tuesday. Tuesday's household waste will be collected on Wednesday, Wednesday's recycling will be picked up on Thursday, Thursday's household waste will be picked up on Friday and Friday's household waste will be picked up on Saturday. The following week will resume the normal service days.

SIGN UP FORM FOR COLLECTION SERVICE

Please fill out and deliver in person to 121 Evergreen Road. Payment is required at the time of sign up. Full quarter (three months) is \$74.00. If service is started during a quarter, the charge will be prorated based on the number of weeks remaining in the current quarter. Payment is by check, cash, on line bill payment through your bank or money order. The collection service includes once a week pick up for household waste, every other week for recycling and once per month for bulky waste. The service will also include a free, recycling rewards program beginning on or about April 1, 2012. It generally takes one week to start service. To determine your collection schedule for household waste, recycling and bulky waste, please refer to the 2012 Calendar. To determine which Section you are in for household waste, bulky waste and recycling, please use the Interactive Map or click on Trash/Bulk Pickup Map, Street Listing and Recycle Map.
